Project FILL in (2014)

Project Fill in

The project *FILL in* (2014) consisted of a series of artistic, participatory activities. There was a picnic in the Źródliska Park that included the oldfashioned games (*Peek-a-boo around the corner*), the knees-up on the pavement (*Enchanting last day of summer*), cooking and sharing a story (*Food for a story*), soundwalks on Księży Młyn (*Hard Shoulder—stories underfoot*) and performances in the Art Book Museum (*Stop-Motion 2.1.*).

As part of its implementation, I managed a team consisting of a graphic designer (posters, information leaflets, a website), a video operator (video documentation, editing), musician (soundtracks for video documentation and video performance, playing live during artistic activities), lector (recording of dialogue tracks for soundwalks), animation director (creating animation based on archives and spoken stories), translator (translating promotional materials and soundtracks into English).




The magazine is registered in the International Publishing Information System under ISSN 2657-652X and entered in the register of periodicals under No. 1664. It has been published since 2019.







The artistic and scientific magazine "Woof Woof Arf Arf" was published by the Academy of Fine Arts in Krakow and Poznan (2014-2018). Each issue of the magazine was themed (Black Hole, Cordyceps, Canis Vertigus) and based on the open-call formula. Along with the publication nationwide exhibitions and promotional meetings were organized. The magazine was sent to the main art and culture institutions in Poland.

Dream City is a project created by Marta Ostajewska and Justyna Apolinarzak. Nineteen artists from Lodz wrote / drew their dreams in a hand-made "Dream Notebook". In the animation based on "Dream Notebook", their dreams intertwine with realistic images of Old Polesie, Bałuty, Retkinia. The premiere of the animated film Dream City, the exhibition (presentation of notebooks) and improvisation for dreams and cellos (live mixing of images from notebooks, reading fragments of dreams and improvisation for cellos) took place at the Book Art Museum in Lodz in December 2016. The second presentation of the project was held at the Museum of Cinematography in Lodz in 2018.


